

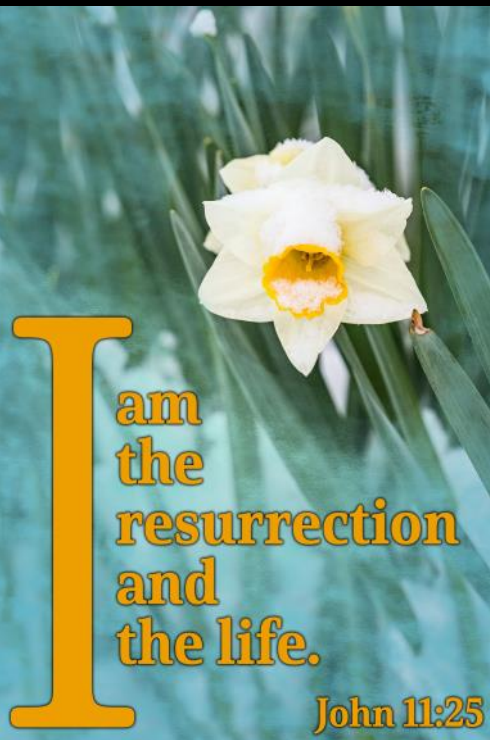

"Christmas in July Craft Show"

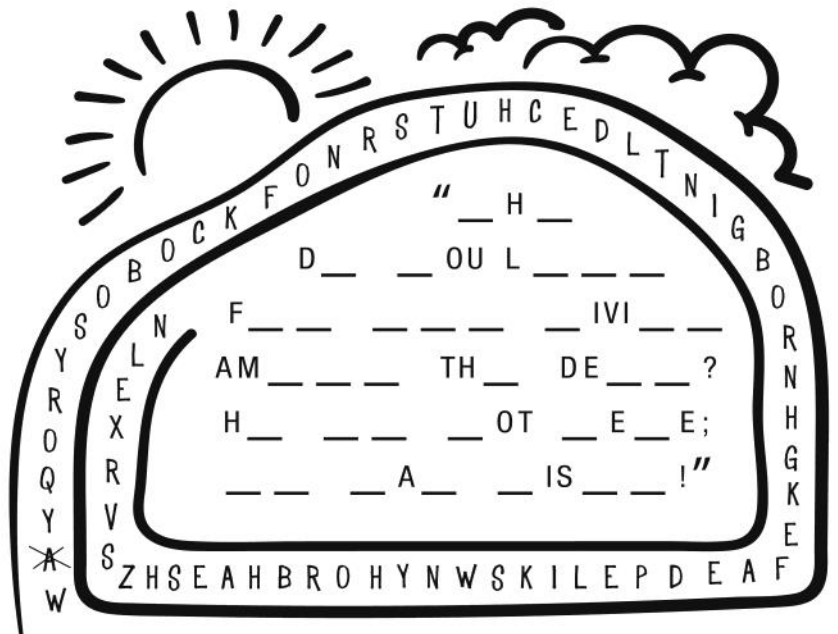
