

Peace Lutheran Church - Opening guidelines Rev 06/10/2020

Pastor will perform all "ALTAR GUILD DUTIES" until further notice

Face masks should be worn throughout the service

There should be no touching, hugging, handshakes, or pats on the shoulder, and please maintain the 6 foot minimum distancing

The main doors to the sanctuary will be open and must remain open. In addition, the inner doors by the outside door will be propped open throughout the service

Entrance to the fellowship hall is blocked

The back of the pews where people may sit will be wiped down prior to the start of service, after which 2 bulletins will be placed, one at each end of the pews to show which pews may be occupied

The offering plate will be placed by the baptismal font

People attending will be asked to remain in their cars until the church doors are unlocked approximately 10 minutes before the start of the service. That individual will open the church doors so only he will be touching the door handle. We will do this for both the west door (main entrance) and the north door (parking lot entrance). Please maintain social distancing as you enter the church. When everyone is inside, the doors will be closed, locked, and sanitized

When entering the church, please enter the sanctuary immediately, go to a pew, and be seated

You will find painters tape on the pews where seating is not available

Bulletins are located where you can sit

One family may sit together in a pew ... otherwise maintain two people, one at each end of every pew

An usher or elder will dismiss by row to maintain social distancing starting from the back of church

Service bulletins must be discarded in the trashcan next to the offering plate or taken home after the service

After dismissal, please immediately leave the church and proceed to your car. You may socialize in the parking lot but please remember to maintain appropriate social distancing

Bathrooms -- We encourage people to use them only in an emergency, sanitize your hands with hand sanitizer that is provided, and then clean each area touched with the Lysol spray provided

Please email or call the church for additions to the prayer list. The prayer list will be placed on the altar by pastor before service. Speak with Pastor Tkac or text him before the service if you have a late prayer request (248-821-2727)

After the service, the cleaning crew will disinfect the pews and all door handles etc., and the spray cans of Lysol in the bathrooms will be wiped down with a disinfecting wipe
