

Ladies Guild Missions Pavement Repairs



Create some invisible art and then reveal the seasonal design.

#### What you need:

- Leaves
- White paper
- White crayon (label removed)
- · Watercolor paints
- Water
- Paintbrush

#### What you do:

- Gather leaves of different shapes and sizes. On a table, arrange them flat without overlaps. Set the paper over them.
- 2. Hold the crayon sideways and use the long edge to color over the leaves. You'll make an invisible rubbing of them.
- 3. Then paint over the paper with watercolors. The areas with crayon will resist the paint and reveal the hidden leaf designs.

**Sunday School** begins September 18th. At 9:15 am— 10:15 am. Ages 3yrs-5th grade are invited to register for Sunday School.


### **Church's 60th Anniversary**
